Dan. 12:13

“But go thou thy way till the end be; for thou shalt rest, and stand in thy lot at the end of the days.”

The Book of Daniel outlines the last half of Israel's history.

The 10th and 11th chapters outline the main King's during the 70th week.

-CH. 10: Cyrus and the 4 kings of Persia.

-CH. 11: Alexander the Great, Ptolemy Philadelphus, Antiochus the Great,
Antiochus Epiphanies, Maccabees, Herod the Great, Christ.

This verse is the concluding thoughts of all the prophecy Daniel has received.

But go thou thy way till the end be... When it is over and done with. Go until Daniels death.

...for thou shalt rest: Daniels body in the grave and his soul in heaven.

...and stand in thy lot at the end of the days. Daniels inheritance he will receive.

...stand in thy lot...

This statement begs the question:

What is your lot?

Man, who at the beginning was created happy, Gen. 1.26;

Having now lost God and his image, is, become most miserable; no less than a slave of the devil, a child of wrath, and an heir of eternal damnation.

What is your Inheritance?
