Amos wrote of the visions he received in 750 B.C.

Assyria empire (**2 head in Rev. 13**) part of the Kingdom of Satan is the world power.

Amos was from Judah but prophesied to Israel-Northern Kingdom.

**Amos 7:10**

Then Amaziah the priest (**fellow minister**) of Bethel sent to Jeroboam king of Israel, saying, **Amos hath conspired against thee in the midst of the house of Israel: the land is not able to bear all his words.**

**All priest/ministers do not serve under same mandate.**

Amos was concerned with truth and careful to guard the message.

**1- Amos not motivated by money.****Amos 7:12**

**“Also Amaziah said unto Amos, O thou seer, go, flee thee away (invited to leave) into the land of Judah, and there eat bread (make more money), and prophesy there.”**

**I feel for Amos** – having been invited to leave by two churches in fourteen months.As soon as I joined, one pastor in Frankfort said, without consulting the church, “if you are interested in mission work we will support you.” (**Some pay to play- I was offered pay to leave.**)**Note:**

All ministers do not work under the same commission.

**2- Amos not afraid of losing 501-C-3 status.****Amos 7:13**

**But prophesy not again any more at Bethel: for it is the king's chapel, and it is the king's court.**

**3- Amos says here is an account of myself, so listen carefully.**

**Amos 7:14-17**

<sup>14</sup> Then answered Amos, and **said to Amaziah**, I was no prophet, neither was I a prophet's son; but I was an herdman, and a gatherer of sycomore fruit:

<sup>15</sup> And the LORD took me as I followed the flock, and the LORD said unto me, Go, prophesy unto my people Israel.

<sup>16</sup> **Now therefore hear thou the word of the LORD:** Thou sayest, Prophesy not against Israel, and drop not *thy word* against the house of Isaac.

<sup>17</sup> **Therefore thus saith the LORD;** Thy wife shall be an harlot in the city, and thy sons and thy daughters shall fall by the sword, and thy land shall be divided by line; and thou shalt die in a polluted land: and Israel shall surely go into captivity forth of his land.

**Amos just told the priest, God will destroy you.**

**1-** You wife will become a prostitute.

**2-** Your children will be murdered.

**3-** You will lose your home.

**4-** And... you will die.

**\*\***Also the Northern Kingdom will be led into captivity by the 2<sup>nd</sup> head of the beast that comes out of the sea.

**Rev. 13:1**

And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads... (Assyria is 2<sup>nd</sup> head)
