3) Kingdom's citizens must be paid for.

**Savior** = For ye are bought with a price... (1 Cor. 6:20)

Lord=therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's. (1 Cor. 6:20)

4) Kingdom's citizens must enter an everlasting Kingdom

(This Kingdom is operated by the Lord and Savior)

**Savior** = For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ... (2Peter 1:11)

**Lord=** Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye Know *them*, and be established in the present truth...(2 Peter 1:12)

## Do you know Jesus as both Lord and Savior of your life?

#### Consider this:

**Savior** =For if when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be <u>saved by his life</u>" (Romans 5:10.)
